

Friedrich Schiller University Jena cordially welcomes families into everyday university life and actively supports the balancing of family life and work. This guide is intended to give a first overview of the various types of childcare. If you have questions, the Family Office is happy to help you.

## Important:

In Germany, parents of children over the age of one are legally entitled to a childcare place. Depending on the child's age, parents may choose from various types of childcare:

Age	Type of care
0–3 years	<ul> <li>Childminder</li> <li>Small group with a maximum of five children per childminder</li> <li>Costs according to the regulations of the city of Jena</li> <li>Childcare before the age of one is possible (e.g. if parents are employed → proof required).</li> </ul>
1–6 years	<ul> <li>Day care ('Kita')</li> <li>Group sizes may vary depending on the facility</li> <li>Costs according to the regulations of the city of Jena</li> <li>From the age of three, childcare is only possible in a day care centre.</li> <li>Childcare before the age of one is possible (e.g. if both parents are employed → proof required).</li> <li>University employees/students will be given priority for places in the day care centres operated by the student services organization Studierendenwerk Thüringen.</li> </ul>
3 months to 10 years	<ul> <li>Flexible childcare 'JUniKinder'</li> <li>Care on an hourly basis (one unit = two hours)</li> <li>Maximum four hours per day and maximum ten hours per week</li> <li>Directly on campus</li> <li>Information and registration via the INFOtake</li> </ul>

Application for a childminder	<ul> <li>You can obtain information directly from the childminders or from the childminding advisory service of the city of Jena.</li> <li>Places are allocated by the childminding advisory service of the city of Jena.</li> </ul>
Application for a place in day care	<ul> <li>Places are allocated via the online portal for day care of the city of Jena.</li> <li>You can reserve a place in up to five day care centres.</li> <li>You may apply from the day of the child's birth.</li> <li>You will receive a confirmation from the day care centre in your account in the online portal.</li> <li>The confirmation is temporary and expires after 21 days if you do not confirm it.</li> </ul>
Enrolment as guest children	<ul> <li>If the child stays in Jena for a maximum of three months, it will generally be admitted as guest child. → Directly apply to the day care centre.</li> <li>Fees = 10 euros per day (without income check)</li> </ul>
Childcare costs	<ul> <li>The fees payable by the parents are generally calculated on the basis of</li> <li>the monthly average income,</li> <li>the number of children entitled to child benefits living with the parent(s),</li> <li>the time of care.</li> </ul>
Cost-free year in day care	In Thuringia, children who are six years old on 1 August are considered to be of compulsory school age. No fees are payable for them in the 12 months before they start school. An application is not required.
