Credit Transfer	Generally, in Wuhan University one credit consists of 18 class hours, assignments and a final exam. Any academic credit received in Wuhan University may be transferred to your home university in accordance with the regulations of your home University.				
Transcripts	Students can request your official final transcript in the Teaching Affairs Office of SIE once you finish all exams. Results are usually ready in about a week after the exam. In the event that results are not available before your departure, you can authorize a third-party to collect your transcript (recommended) or choose to mail the transcript to a home address (postage payment involved).

Procedure	Partner Universities will nominate students sending us their names and family names (as reported on their passports), e-mail address, degree course, field of study and duration of the mobility (one semester or one academic year). And the exchange students should complete their online application. The nomination and the application both should be done before the deadline.

Considerations for Nomination & Application	Students complete online application and upload application documents before the deadline at http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/member/login.do or http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/ It should be noted that Chinese nationality students cannot apply for this system, and students who have registered before do not need to register again.				
	After that, you will get a PDF document from this website and then send it to your home institution's exchange coordinator. The home institution's exchange coordinator will e-mail your signed application material to us (inbound@whu.edu.cn) before the deadline .				
	Please pay attention that the entire nominated student's information and their signed application materials should be sent together by our exchange partners abroad to inbound@whu.edu.cn				
	You will receive the admission materials one month later after we get the nomination e-mail, as there are three different sections involved in issuing the admission letter.				
	Please note: In order to ensure the smooth arrival of admission materials, materials will be sent to the program coordinator directly but NOT to students, so please provide the accurate mailing address of your university.

Visa Requirements

After receiving the Admission Letter from WHU, the applicant should submit the visa application package to the Chinese Embassy/Consulate General to apply for X visa. Within 180 days: X2 visa (would NOT be converted into other visas after registering in WHU) Over 180 days: X1 visa (would be converted into a residence permit after registering in WHU)

Please note: If entering China with other types of Visa, you will be not allowed to register in Wuhan University. It's impossible to get X visa in China, you need apply X visa before you come.

Transportation& Registration

We do not provide pick-up service, but you can follow the map which will be delivered to you together with the admission letter. For your convenience, we recommend that you take the taxi to arrive at school in the Luojia Gate (珞 珈门). After your admission letter (录取通知书) showed to the security personnel, the taxi can enter the campus.

You will be required to register and pay the application and accommodation fees in the School of International Education Wuhan University (武汉大学国际教育学院).

The Chinese above can be provided to the taxi driver in order that you get to the right place.

The issues after exchange students' arrival should be in the charge of the School of International Education.

	Please note: Students must enroll on time. If you cannot arrive on time due to any special reason, please apply for deferred registration (within 7 days) with the signature of your home institution's coordinator at the admissions office in the School of International Education. We do NOT accept deferred registration beyond 7 days.
Orientation	Orientation will be held for all new international students within one month after the semester begins. Orientation activities are designed to help newcomers adapt to new campus life, offering useful tips and advice on all aspects of student life (choosing courses, etc.).
Departure	All exchange students are required to complete a leaving-school procedure before their departure. The Departure Form is available upon request at the Teaching Affairs Office of SIE.

Health insurance	Please note: All the students are required to pay for the local health insurance according to the regulation of our country. 400 RMB per semester, 800 RMB per year. Two days before your entry, please purchase insurance according to the instructions in the "Online Payment Process of Insurance for International Students in China". If you need to seek medical
	treatment due to covid-19 or other diseases during the quarantine period (when you arrive in China but not on campus), you are supposed to contact the insurance company to pay for the treatment expenses in accordance with the regulations of the medical insurance for international students studying in China.
