SCHOLARSHIPS

Undergraduate Scholarships

Undergraduate students are eligible to apply for two scholarships that are reduced from our annual tuition fee of \$12,942: the Coyote Beginnings Scholarship and the Coyote **Beginnings Grant**. The Coyote Beginnings Scholarship is automatically awarded to first-time freshman applicants students at the time of admission, with a value of up to \$4,000 per year based on high school GPA. The Coyote Beginnings Grant is automatically awarded to first-time freshman who have a qualifying SAT or ACT score. This award is valued between \$1,500 to \$2,500 per year and may be stacked on top of the Coyote Beginnings Scholarship. Students who receive the high end of both awards would achieve the equivalent of a half-tuition scholarship.

Graduate Assistantships

The sole scholarships available to graduate students come in the form graduate assistantships, which provide qualified post-baccalaureate students financial assistance in exchange for their teaching, research, and service efforts to the University. Think of these like a job, as you submit an applicaiton for a GA position at the time of admission or shortly after. Like a job, there is no set formula to receive a GA; rather, departments will review your entire application holistically and select candidates that best meet the job description. Teaching and research assistantships are awarded by individual departments and are highly competitive. Assistantships come with a 2/3 tuition reduction plus a semester stipend.


