TEACHING AWARDS 2024

In addition to a themed teaching prize, which focuses on "Special commitment in teaching", the University of Jena also awards a general teaching prize for the best course concept (€ 2,500).

TEACHING AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony and presentation of the award-winning teaching concepts will take place as part of this year's DIES LEGENDI – Teaching Day on 19 November 2024.

SELECTION PROCESS

WHO SELECTS THE AWARD WINNERS?

The panel of experts of the Academy for Teaching Development selects the award winners on the basis of the nomination documents received.

WHAT ARE THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

Teaching concepts that are rated as outstanding in at least one of the following criteria can receive a teaching award:

- innovative teaching methods and learning materials are used in a target group-specific manner;
- the didactic design of the course supports the learning process and success of the students in a special way;
- exemplary forms of interaction between teachers and students are used.

NOMINATION PROCESS FOR THE GENERAL TEACHING AWARD

WHAT CAN BE NOMINATED?

Courses taught by all professors working in teaching at the Friedrich Schiller University Jena

- professors
- research assistants.

In addition to courses taught by individual teachers, courses taught by teams can also be proposed.

WHO MAY NOMINATE?

- students (a minimum of five)
- subject-specific student representative committees
- academic employees
- professors

HOW CAN NOMINATIONS BE SUBMITTED?

In addition to nominations by students and/or other teachers, direct applications are also possible.

In order to submit a nomination, a nomination form is to be completed.

The completed form, together with the other necessary nomination documents, then must be sent to the Academy for Teaching Development by **5 May 2024** (exclusion period) via email (ale@uni-jena.de).
