
# City of Gwangju and Yeosu Chonnam National University

Gwangju is designated as an "International Safe Community" by International Safe Community Certifying Centre (ISCCC)




## Yeosu

# **Nomination and Application**



## **Nomination**

CNU Office of International Affairs will email the nomination URL to all of our partner universities. The home institutions will select qualified students, and fill out the online form with the following information.

First and Last name, Gender, Major/Intended Area of Study, Birthdate (MM/DD/YY), Email address, CGPA, and Intended Term of Study



## **Application**

CNU Office of International Affairs will email all nominated student(s) the URL for starting their online incoming exchange student application.

## **Acceptance**

CNU Office of International Affairs will email the home institution and mail official acceptance packets containing an Acceptance letter, Certificate of Admission, and the documents necessary to apply for a student visa [D-2].

Accepted students are advised to wait to make travel plans and embassy/consulate visits until they have received their official acceptance packet.



## Visa Requirements

The regulations for obtaining a visa are subject to change. Successful applicants will receive a "Certificate of Admission" from CNU. Students are required to apply for a Student Visa (D-2) at a Korean embassy/consulate located in their home countries. After arriving in Korea, all exchange students are required to visit the Gwangju Immigration Office to apply for an Alien Registration Card. The card will be used as an ID (residence permit) during their stay here in Korea. It takes 3 weeks on average to have it issued.



### **Health Insurance**

Pursuant to the Korean National Health Insurance (NHI) Law and Regulations, all international students, including exchange students, who plan to stay in Korea for more than three months, are required to enroll in the nation-wide mandatory insurance plan at their own expenses. This mandatory plan will cost about USD 40 per month. Please note that this plan is required even when you have a similar insurance coverage from your home country.

Cost: 40 USD/month

Various benefits are available, including dental and oriental medical treatment, and pregnancy and childbirth-related medical expenses.

- \* The above is inapplicable to non-covered items, such as treatment for diseases that do not affect work or daily life (example: plastic surgery)
  - Outpatient Medical Service: 30%-60% of the NHI, covering expenses (varies by medical care institution type and area)
  - Hospitalization Expenses: 20%
  - Immediate Coverage: The insured is not required to claim benefits after receiving treatment.
  - Number and Amount of Benefits: The number and amount of benefits are not limited

In addition to the mandatory (minimum) plan discussed above, all international students at CNU are required to be covered by additional health insurance during their entire course of study. CNU has partnered with a local insurance company to provide an insurance plan for our international students. All international students must purchase this private insurance coverage that covers the following

## **Transcripts**

CNU Office of International Affairs will order one official copy of the incoming exchange student's Chonnam National University transcript to be sent directly to the home institution, upon completion of the student's studies.

## **CNU Student Cards**

All new students will be issued a CNU student card. This card serves as a student ID, library card, and allows access to a variety of on-campus service. It is also can be used as a public transit card in Gwangju.

## **Academic Notes**

Students need to fill out the form and send it to the CNU coordinator before the due date via email. The CNU coordinator will register the courses on behalf of the students but their choices cannot be guaranteed. Every first week of the semester, there is a "course add and drop" period, so student can add, or drop courses after their arrival at CNU. Course registration will be finalized after this period.

Students' home institutions have set the policy regarding the awarded credits for coursework completed at CNU. Students are responsible for knowing their home institutions' policies and procedures regarding this matter.

Important Academic information: CNU subscribes to the system of Korean Credit. CNU requires exchange students to take at least 6 Korean credits (about 9 ECTS) per semester. A single course at CNU usually grants 3 credits.

(Workloads /Course = 3 hours a week, total of 45 hours per semester)

- Minimum credits to maintain CNU student status: 3 credits per semester
- Maximum credits for exchange students are allowed to take: 18 credits per semester

## **CNU Merit Scholarship**

Merit scholarship is available to the incoming exchange students.

- Eligibility: CNU exchange student with at least CGPA 85 out of 100
  - CGPA 40%
  - Foreign Language Proficiency Score (TOPIK, TOEFL, TOEIC, DELE, DELF, IELTS, JLPT, HSK, ZD, etc.) 30%
  - Self-introduction essay 15%
  - Study Plan 15%
  - (Extra points) students who joined an incoming program (exchange student, short-term, internship, etc.) at CNU before will get extra 10 points.
- Number of Students: 5 students every semester
- Benefits: Dormitory and meal plan fee waiver
- □ Application Procedure
  - 1. CNU Office of International Affairs will select 5 students among the incoming exchange program applicants by above 4 criteria.
  - 2. The accepted students will be informed via email.

## **CNU Best Partner Scholarship**

Best partner scholarship is available to the incoming exchange students.

CNU checks the exchange balance at the end of every year. If CNU sent 2 more students than partner university did in the preceding year, CNU will award 500,000 KRW scholarship up to 3 students from the partner university upcoming semester. The accepted students will be informed via email.

## Scholarship 'Global Korea Scholarship'

Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) is available for incoming exchange students.

- Eligibility: CNU exchange student with at least CGPA 85 out of 100
- Number of Students: 4-5 Students every semester
- Benefits
  - Round-trip Flight Ticket
  - Settlement Support allowance: 200,000 KRW
  - Monthly allowance: 500,000 KRW per month
  - Health Insurance

#### □ Application Procedure

- 1. CNU Office of International Affairs will select up to 10 students among the incoming exchange program applicants by their CGPA descending order.
- 2. CNU Office of International Affairs will select 5-6 students based on the CGPA, TOPIK score, official foreign language score, and study plan among the 10 students.
- 3. CNU will send the list of selected students to the Ministry of Education and the accepted students will be informed via email.


