

How to Submit your Master Thesis

In order to register your Master thesis, please submit the following documents to the examination office (ASPA):

- the completed Master Thesis Registration Form (available at ASPA information desk/on ASPA homepage,
- proof of satisfied foreign language requirements according to § 3 Study Regulations (originals or certified copies of school leaving certificate/further certificates if applicable),
- If you intend to write the thesis in team work a separate application is required.

The Processing of your Thesis

- The deadline for submitting your application is the <u>10th</u> of each month.
- Once you have submitted all required documents approval of your application will follow by the <u>15th</u> of the month.
- In accordance with the FSU Master Examination Rules, the examination of your thesis (inclusive of possible presentation/defense) from the date of admission will take:

• Three bound copies and an electronic version (CD ROM/different media) of the thesis must be submitted by the given deadline but within the opening hours of the examination office.

The Layout of your Master Thesis

- The thesis must be printed on A4 paper using one-and-a-half-spacing,
- should not usually exceed 80 pages (160.000 characters),
- Structure, references and annotations must be based on the usual standards followed in the given academic discipline,
- contains a title page and declaration of authorship on the last page of the thesis. (Please note the samples overleaf).

Further standards are not prescribed but we strongly recommend consulting your supervisor in this matter.

Declaration of Authorship (wording suggestion)
