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Legal capacity regarding financing / conclusion of contracts / right of residence

In Germany, most financial matters require a bank account. For recurring payments such as rental fees, electricity costs, costs of using mobile phones, or in order to receive an EC card, it is necessary to open a German bank account. Both parents must sign the account application, as most banks in Germany do not accept power of attorney for this process. Therefore, students under 18 years of age are required to be accompanied by their parents in their first days in Jena.

Legal capacity also refers to the conclusion of contracts like rental agreements and applications for a residence permit. For such matters, a legal representative (parent) has to be present, too.
